Student Scholarship Application Information and Instructions

Rancho Cucamonga High School Cougar Booster Club scholarships are to encourage diverse student development and growth through participation and achievement in high school and community activities. It does so by highlighting senior students' four-year school and higher education goals. The scholarship selection is based on the point score achieved from broad-based criteria. It recognizes and gives credit for academic excellence, school awards, honors and participation and leadership positions in school organizations. It also encourages and recognizes the value of volunteer and community service work and non-school achievements. And finally, it fosters participation in the mission of the Booster Club.

Booster Club scholarships are one-time annual awards given to up to six outstanding seniors seeking higher education. The number and amount of scholarships are based on available funds. The selection is based on top overall point scores from criteria established by the Booster Club and set forth below. Scoring and verification of information will be done by the Booster Club.

Any Rancho Cucamonga High School senior pursuing continuing education is eligible to compete for a Booster Club scholarship. They are only required to complete and submit a Booster Club Scholarship Application to be considered for a scholarship. Scholarship recipients will be notified by the Cougar Booster Club. Questions regarding the application should be directed to any Cougar Booster Club Board member.
